Instrumental Program Agreement 2009

Please read the following agreement before signing this document.

- 1. All students will care for the instruments hired from the College. Parents and students will be liable for the replacement or repair of instruments that are damaged, lost or stolen due to negligence.**
2. Instrumental hire will be charged at \$30.00 per term and is payable as part of the instrumental account which will be sent to you in the first week of each term.
3. Fees for the instrumental tuition are payable for the term in advance. Your instrumental account must be paid within the specified time period when receiving the account. Failure to pay your account by the stipulated due date will result in the instrumental lessons being terminated. If an instrument has been hired from the College it will also need to be returned.
4. In the instance that your instrumental account has not been finalised by the due date and the lessons and hire have been terminated you will still be liable for the full amount stipulated on the account.
5. Students who have had their lessons terminated will be reinstated into the Instrumental Program once the full amount stipulated on the instrumental account has been finalised. Any lessons that have been forfeited during this time will not be credited to your account.
6. Parents / guardians who have difficulty paying their instrumental account or have an enquiry regarding their account must contact the Account Department at the College.
7. If a student does not receive all lessons that have been paid in advance in the case where a termination of lessons has not occurred then that student will be credited for the lessons not received on their next instrumental account. If the student is not continuing instrumental lessons in the following term then any credits owing will be transferred to the student's general school account.
8. Students wishing to terminate their lessons for any reason will be required to notify the Director of Music in writing of the termination. **One term's notice must be given.** Failure to provide one term's notice will result in you paying for the next term's instrumental account and this will be at the discretion of the Director of Music.
9. The Director of Music will exercise the right to terminate a student's instrumental tuition at any time if it is deemed that the termination will be in the best interest of the student and / or their instrumental tutor. Parents and students will be given notice if such action is required.

10. Students are to be punctual to all instrumental lesson and rehearsals relating to their chosen ensemble (refer to point 15 and 16). A weekly timetable will be provided to students enrolled in the Instrumental Program for their lesson times.
11. The instrumental tutor, Student Services and / or Department of Music require 24 hours notice if the student is unable to attend a scheduled lesson or rehearsal due to a school event or excursion. Failure to give appropriate notice will result in the full cost of the lesson being charged. No credit will be given.
12. In the instance that a student is ill on the day of their lesson or rehearsal they must notify either the instrumental tutor, Department of Music or Student Services. Failure to notify either the instrumental tutor, Department of Music or Student Services of an absence will result in the full cost of the lesson being charged. No credit will be given.
13. Every student in the Instrumental Program will be provided with a Daily Practice Record Journal that the instrumental tutor will use to record weekly tasks for the student to achieve. The student must use this booklet and parents are strongly encouraged to regularly sight this book and sign it on a weekly basis.
14. Any instrumental books or external examinations that are recommended by the instrumental tutor must be purchased and paid for by the parent / guardian.
15. ***All students who are enrolled in the Instrumental Program must be involved in an approved ensemble.*** Students are expected to be available for the ensembles rehearsals that take place after school. This will be monitored diligently.
16. Any student who is absent from their ensembles rehearsals three or more times during one term will be terminated from the Instrumental Program. You will still be liable for the full account and no credits will be issued. This will be monitored diligently. Any hired instrument will need to be returned to the College immediately.
17. All queries relating to your child's involvement in the Instrumental Program must be forwarded to the Director of Music.
