### ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable enrolment application fee of **A\$100** is payable on submission of the Enrolment Form.

## **(A) TUITION FEES**

The tuition fee is used to cover the costs of educating the student.

In addition, the tuition fee covers Student Personal Accident and Disability Insurance. This insurance covers each student for school activities authorized by the Principal and under the control of the school, whether in or out of school time.

Be aware that additional charges apply in some tuition areas, e.g. Religious Education, Outdoor Education, Art, INSTEP. These additional charges will be added during the semester when the student enrolls in particular courses.

## **(B) OTHER LEVIES**

The Building Levy and ICT Levy are compulsory and is used to help pay for capital works and repayment of loans. Additional donations to the Building Fund are most welcome.

Levies that will apply to all families include:

- Building levy of AUD 320 per family
- Information Communications Technology Levy AUD 135 per family

## **(C) MEDICAL INSURANCE (MEDIBANK PRIVATE)**

Each International Student enrolled is required as a visa condition, to purchase Overseas Students Health Cover (OSHC) at **AUD 354** per annum. This must be paid via the school and is required prior to the issue of a Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) document. This fee is subject to change upon notice.

## **(D) CURRICULUM COUNCIL – GOVERNMENT OF WA**

Year 11 and Year 12 students are required to pay an enrolment fee to the Curriculum Council. The fee is collected by the College and forwarded to the Curriculum Council. Year 10 students choosing to study courses which contribute to secondary graduation may also be required to pay an enrolment fee to the Curriculum Council. These courses are referred to as 'D' Code and 'E' Code courses. This fee is subject to change upon notice.

## BILLING SCHEDULE

In the October prior to the beginning of the school year, an account for the annual tuition fee will be forwarded to the parents/guardian.

### ***For NEW and CONTINUING students***

To secure a place for 2009 the total fees for

- Semester 1 tuition fees plus Building Levy, Medibank Private, and Curriculum Council fees must be paid in full by 28 November, 2008.
- Semester 2 tuition fees must be paid in full by 15 May, 2009.

A 'Confirmation of Enrolment' will then be issued to new students.

If fees are not paid by the above due date, it will be assumed by the College that the student is not returning, and enrolment will be withdrawn. The Department of Immigration and Multicultural Affairs will be notified.

If an enrolment for a new student is taken after the due date, payment for the Semester must be made within 14 days of acceptance.

### ***For students NOT continuing:***

Confirmation in writing must be received 10 weeks prior to the commencement of the semester if a student is NOT continuing. Failure to adhere to this will result in a charge of:

#### PENALTY

- 30% of total semester tuition fee
- 60% of total semester tuition fee

#### NOTIFICATION PERIOD

- Between 4 and 10 weeks before start of semester
- 4 weeks or less before start of semester

An account for any additional fees and charges such as camps and levies, will be forwarded at the beginning of term 1 and is to be paid within 21 calendar days.

An account for Semester 2 levies will be sent at the beginning of Term 3 and is to be paid within 21 calendar days.

No fee discounts are available to International Students in 2009.

## REFUND POLICY

A copy of the College's Refund Policy is provided with the application form at the time of enrolment and must be read, signed by both the student and the parent/guardian, and returned to the College.
